Frequently Asked Questions

Do all my users have to be on a Skype plan to attend meetings?

No. Only the meeting organizers will need the Skype with Conferencing plan to send meeting invites that include dial-in phone numbers. Attendees who don't have the Skype plan will be able to attend from any browser or mobile device using the free app.

Can I add Dial-in Conferencing to other Office 365 Plans?

Dial-in conferencing (also called PSTN Conferencing) can be added to Business Essentials, Business Premium, E1, E3 and E5 Enterprise plans.

I'm also looking at other online conferencing apps. Why is Skype for Business better?
